We are so glad you have chosen the Alford Youth & Community Center to host your special occasion rental! Our main goal is for everyone to have fun, but of course, we do need to assure the safety of everyone within our facility. Here are a few ground rules. ADVENTURE PLAYLAND PARTY RULES

- Parties include one hour party-set up time, one hour in the private party room and 25 day passes for the bounce house for up to 25 children, age 12 and under; 3 large one-topping pizzas, and 3 large bottles of water.
- All parties are booked during public hours and are NOT PRIVATE. The general public has full access to the bounce houses during this time.
- The bounce houses are for children age 12 and under.
- Socks are required for all children utilizing the bounce houses. Socks can be purchased at the attendant's desk for \$1.00 per pair.
- All belongings should be placed in the party room.
- Each guest parent must check-in with the attendant's desk.
- Pizza and beverages arrive at the beginning of the specified party room time. If additional pizza is requested, the order must be placed by 9:30am, the day of the party. Additional pizzas are \$10.00/each.
- No going behind the equipment.
- Should an inflatable begin losing air, the equipment MUST be exited immediately.
- Any accidents/injuries should be reported to the Playland Attendant on duty immediately.
- Use all equipment appropriately.
- Use slide appropriately; bottom down, feet first. No jumping, no going head first, and no climbing up the slide or the sides. Only the ladder is to be used for climbing.
- The obstacle course is one-way only, beginning with the back of the course. No bouncing in the tunnel and no stopping in the middle.
- No climbing on the sides of any equipment.
- Please adhere to ages listed on bounce equipment.

These rules are for the safety of you and the children in the Adventure Playland. We hope that you respect our effort to keep a safe environment. If the rules are not followed, the Playland Attendant may ask that your child refrain from utilizing our equipment and/or be asked to leave.

AYCC GENERAL FACILITY RULES

- The named contact person listed on the party contract is liable for their guests and for any damages to the facility. This person is responsible for the cleanliness of the party room spaces and will be expected to assure all trash is placed appropriately in trash receptacles and the general cleanliness of the room is maintained. The AYCC's housekeeping staff does a quick sweep, wipe of tables and trash removal in between parties. Excessive messes left by the party will be billed to the contracted party contact.
- At least one adult must be with the children providing appropriate supervision during the entirety of the party. The Alford Youth & Community Center staff are not responsible for the children during the party.
- NO smoking/vaping is allowed on the AYCC grounds (including the parking lot). No drugs or alcohol are permitted on AYCC property, including marijuana.
- Rough housing, fighting, wrestling and physical violence is not tolerated.
- NO RUNNING.
- Refunds will only be given if 48 hours or more notice is given. There will be a processing fee of \$10.00. Rescheduling of a party can take place, depending on space available.
- The AYCC provides 2 plain white, paper tablecloths for each party as well as tables and chairs.
- Set-up/decoration of the party room takes place at the first hour of the contracted, printed party room time. Earlier set-up times and late stays increase the price of the party.
- The use of confetti, glitter bombs, or other messy party supplies are strictly prohibited in the facility.
- No packing/duct tape, thumb tacks, nails or other methods of attaching decorations to the walls is allowed. Removal of AYCC artwork or wall décor is prohibited. Please see the Welcome Center staff if you would like to hang items.
- No candles or other items causing smoke can be used in the facility.
- Decorations, gifts and belongings should be removed from the party room at the end of the specified party contract time. Trash should be placed in the trash cans provided by the AYCC.
- Limited space is available in the refrigerator/freezer for cake and ice cream.
- The kitchen and the use of kitchen tools and supplies without contracted permission is unacceptable. The ice machine and refrigerator/freezer usage must be approved by Welcome Center staff prior to usage.

You are responsible for the safety and behavior of all party guests in attendance. The Alford Youth & Community Center and its staff are not responsible for supervision of children, or for lost/stolen items.

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
